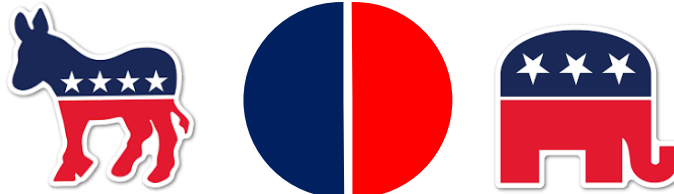

2025 Bipartisan Contributions



In 2025, the first session of the 119th Congress, Mizuho Americas PAC **contributed \$35,000**, equally split between Democrats and Republicans, to U.S. House and U.S. Senate leaders, as well as members serving on key committees overseeing our industry.

Mizuho Americas PAC's bipartisan approach reflects our commitment to advancing policy solutions based on impact and relevance rather than partisan alignment.

2026 Action Plan

In 2026, an **election year** with heightened political activity and increased policymaker engagement, Mizuho Americas PAC will focus on maximizing its impact by aligning resources, participation, and outreach with the Congressional cycle.

Your contributions to Mizuho Americas PAC mean we will have the resources to prioritize **early strategic engagement** with incumbent Congressional candidates. Recognizing that election years present both opportunity and urgency, the PAC will act early to ensure Mizuho's voice is heard at critical moments.
